Whiskies of the World Expo, one of the largest and most popular consumer whisky tasting events in the US, has today announced the competition results of the Whiskies of the World Awards. The awards, launched last fall, are a new venture by the Whiskies of the World team supported by the expertise of its London-based parent company, the International Wine & Spirit Competition.

This year's essential role of judging included a blind tasting, consisting of a panel of Texas tastemakers, all influential figures in the Texan drinks industry.
